EDUCATION THAT LASTS A LIFETIME

We want to make it easy for those who recently moved here to find what they need in terms of childcare and schools. No matter how old your children are, it is important that you have quick and easy access to information about the available alternatives. Östersund is also the home of Mid Sweden University, the university in Sweden closest to a mountain range.

CHILDCARE. When it comes to choosing childcare, there may be many questions. Contact us and let us provide guidance. In short, the municipality offers preschool places for children ages 1–5, including 24 hour preschool care, family day-care homes and open preschools. Once the child starts school, they are also offered a place at an after-school centre until 31 July of the year the child turns 10. Additionally, there are also leisure clubs for children ages 10–12 that are open from the end of the school day until 17:00. SCHOOL AND UPPER-SECONDARY SCHOOL. The municipality houses both municipal and privately owned schools. Contact us and we will provide assistance in finding the right school for your child. The easiest way to change schools is to notify the old school of where you are intending to move. The child's "school history" will then be sent to the new municipality. You can choose between studies via Lärcentrum at the various universities, regardless of where in the municipality you live.





VALUABLE LEISURE TIME

Nature is a given part of Östersund, with its glittering waters and numerous open-air recreation areas. The view of the mountains and the fresh air are both everyday luxuries. There are also well-kept facilities for both outdoor and indoor activities.

WHITE WINTERS. Not every city can offer downhill skiing in the middle of town. Or close to nine miles of skiing trails. In late winter and early spring, you can enjoy sunny days and activities in Vinterparken, including a long-distance skate track on the Storsjön ice.

PLEASANT SUMMERS. Summer sees Badhusparken and Surfbukten become the starting points for everything from swimming and fishing to boat rides and different forms of water transports. Storsjön has a very active boating life with two marinas, one on each side of the strait. If you want to swim indoor, there are several indoor swimming baths to choose from, with Storsjöbadet being the largest with a water park, water slides and outdoor pools.

ACTIVE ASSOCIATIONS. What are your interests? Art, hunting, sports, music, fly-fishing, dancing or perhaps scuba diving? OUTDOOR DESTINATION TIPS

You can visit a number of nature reserves in and around Östersund. They are easy to reach, either by foot or by bicycle, car, or bus. The most well-known of these is probably Andersön, with its beautiful beaches, hiking trails and ancient remains.

Other excellent outing destinations include the culture and nature trails on Frösön, Peterson-Bergers and Sommahagen, and the Tysjöarna nature reserve. Lövbergaparken is also an excellent spot with walking paths, play areas and a café.

There is a long-standing tradition of arranging everything from large food and music festivals to international sporting events. PEOPLE AND FESTIVITIES

If you value taste experiences, locally produced food craft with consideration taken to animals and the environment, then you are in for a treat. In 2010, Östersund and Region Jämtland Härjedalen were awarded the title of Creative City of Gastronomy by UNESCO. Here you will find many culinary creators in one place, and you will be able to choose among cosy patio dining areas, the market hall, or award winning restaurants.

If you are looking for other forms of culture, there is of course also many different art galleries, museums and theatres. Tingshuset hosts a variety of shows involving music, theatre, culture, dancing, movies and lectures, primarily aimed at young people. Here you will also find a branch of Nationalmuseum at Jamtli. There is also the south Sami culture centre, Gaaltije, a unique arena for Sami art, culture, and knowledge with recurring art exhibits, musical events, lectures and festivals.

FESTIVALS AND EVENTS. Östersund is an established organiser when it comes to major events. The Storsjöyran festival is the oldest city festival in the country and offers music, food and cultural experiences that truly are one of a kind.

The city has also hosted a number of different world championship events, as well as international competitions in Paralympics, cross-country skiing and biathlon, including WC opening rounds where the best athletes in the world duke it out at the Swedish National Stadium.

Another event is Storsjöcupen, a recurring international football tournament for young people at the start of July, with 500 teams from around the world. You can also follow many popular sports in person: football, basketball, ice hockey, harness racing, dressage and show jumping, snowmobile racing and motocross, to name a few.

TRANSPORT

Getting around the municipality is easy. When you are new in town, it might be useful to know how to best get around or travel to and from Östersund.

TRAIN AND AIRPLANE. SJ and Norrtåg offer railway transportation to and from Östersund. A few examples of travel times: to Sundsvall around 2.5 hours, Trondheim around 3.5 hours, Åre around 1 hour, Stockholm 5.5 hours and Umeå 6.5 hours. By plane you fly from Åre Östersund Airport to Arlanda or Umeå Airport in about an hour. There are also direct flights to certain charter destinations.

LOCAL BUSES. Länstrafiken i Jämtland is responsible for public transportation, while urban traffic in Östersund and the airport buses is managed by Nettbuss AB. Bus traffic outside the city, such as to Brunflo, Lit, Häggenås, Orrviken, Hara, Tandsbyn and Fåker, as well as the rest of the county, is handled by several different bus companies. CAR CLUB. If you do not need to use a car on a daily basis, it might be a good idea to join a car club. There are several to choose from. For more information, visit www.ostersund.se/hallbartresande

BICYCLE. Östersund is city well-suited to both everyday cycling and bicycle outings. The area has a well-developed network of bicycle roads spanning close to 150 km in Östersund, Lit and Brunflo. Visit the tourist information office or the municipal reception at the old Österäng school to pick up a bicycle map, or download one from the municipality website and discover the best routes.



HEALTHCARE

In the city and surrounding towns you will find the health centres: Z-gränd, Ripan, Frösön, Lugnvik, Odensala, Torvalla, Lit and Brunflo. When parking in Östersund, be aware that you are allowed to park for up to 24 hours on roads and public parking spaces, provided there are no signs to indicate otherwise. **Also remember that alternate-side parking applies between 1 Oct–31 May.**
