NEED OF PRESCHOOL OR AFTER-SCHOOL CENTRE SUMMER OF 2019

During the summer, we modify our preschool and after-school centre operations depending on demand. During the summer, we keep selected preschools and after-school centres open in various parts of our municipality. To enable us to plan and optimize our resources, we are asking you to inform us, no later than 31 March, of what your child's need of childcare will be during this period.

We request that you, as a custodial parent or guardian, indicate your child's need of childcare on Tempus, our website (www.tempushemma.se) by 31 March 2019. The section below tells you what weeks preschools and after-school centres, respectively, will be open this summer.

Summer-open PRESCHOOL: 8 July to 9 August (Weeks 28-32)

If your child will need preschool during any or all of these weeks, you need to register. If you do not register, we will assume your child will not be attending preschool during this period.

Your child will be placed in a preschool in the same area as the one he or she usually attends. The staff will come from various preschools and will include personnel your child knows.

If you need childcare during this period, register for summer-open preschool on the Tempus site no later than 31 March 2019. After that, the list of children attending will be finalized. If your plans change, you will need to contact the preschool administrator in charge.

Summer-open AFTER-SCHOOL CENTRE: 1 July to 2 August (Weeks 27-31)

If your child will need an after-school centre during any or all of these weeks, you need to register. If you do not register, we will assume your child will not be attending an after-school centre during this period.

If you need childcare during this period, register for summer-open after-school centre on the Tempus site no later than 31 March 2019. After that, the list of children attending will be finalized. If your plans change, you will need to contact the principal in charge.
